 - a. Senator Michael F.Q. San Nicolas, of the 33rd Guam Legislature, presented Legislative Resolution No. 37-33 to the CGFMs. The resolution was made to recognize and commend Guam's CGFMs in observance of March 2015 as "CGFM Month".

7. Guest Speaker Presentation

- a. The guest speaker for today's presentation on "FATCA Foreign Account Tax Compliance Act" is Mr. Edmund Brobesong, CPA, Senior Tax Manager with Ernst & Young. Mr. Brobesong's presentation included the following:
 - i. The law for FATCA was passed in March 2010 and went into effect on July 1, 2014. FATCA was established for the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) to acquire information of U.S. citizens who own foreign entities.
 - ii. Guam has limited sovereign immunity. If GovGuam contracts with someone from the U.S., GovGuam has to provide a withholding certificate (W-8 PSP) from the other party. GovGuam is a foreign entity with respect to U.S. tax law. If GovGuam contracts with someone from Guam, GovGuam has to provide a withholding certificate (W-9) from the other party. GovGuam is a domestic entity with respect to Guam tax law. Withholding certificates are applicable for three years.
