

the changes to the tax code from the
Trump administration's new tax cuts
effective in 2018.

Corporate Taxes

- Flat tax rate of 21%.
- Alternative minimum taxes repealed.
 - 100% bonus depreciation.











- ⇒ For a majority of the tax brackets, the tax rates will go down by about 2-3%.
- \Rightarrow 'Single' status standard deduction will increase by 5,650.
- ⇒ 'Married' status standard deduction will increase by 11,300.
- \Rightarrow No personal exemption (down from 4,050).
- ⇒ Increase in child tax credit
- ⇒ Effective until 12/31/2025.


